- To ensure quality printing results, you must provide a high resolution JPG or PDF file. This file will be quite large, 1 MB or more in size. We can accept files via email up to 10 MB in size. Larger files should be submitted on CD. Files smaller than 500K will likely fall short of the resolution needed for quality printing results.
